BRIEF SUMMARY OF MAJOR GENERAL (Ret'd) JIOJI KONOUSI KONROTE'S CURRICULUM VITAE

Major General Jioji Konousi KONROTE is one of Fiji's most *Outstanding* and *Decorated Military Officer* who was particularly noted for his *Courage, Strong Sense of Morality, Righteousness, Forethought, Professionalism and Adaptability* during his 36x years as a *Solider* and *Military Commander*.

- He is a Graduate of the:

As a soldier Major General KONROTE had served with the 1st Ranger Squadron, Special Air Service of the New Zealand Army (NZSAS).

As a young Officer, he had served as a Platoon Commander with the 1st Battalion of the Royal Hampshire Regiment and a Staff Officer in the Headquarters of the 51st Infantry Brigade, British Far East Land Forces in Hong Kong.

Within the Republic of the Fiji Military Forces, Major General Konrote served as a Commanding Officer of the 1st Battalion Fiji Infantry Regiment, (United Nations Interim Forces-Lebanon) UNIFIL and was appointed Deputy Commander and Chief of Staff RFMF from 1988 to 1996.

In 1997-1999 he was appointed as an Assistant Secretary General of the United Nations and took over as the Force Commander UNIFIL.

Major General Konrote retired from *Active Service* within the ranks of the *RFMF* at the end of his term as *UNIFIL Force Commander* and was appointed *Permanent Secretary for Home Affairs & Immigration in 2000*.

In 2002, he was posted to Canberra as Fiji's High Commissioner to the Commonwealth of Australia and Ambassador Plenipotentiary to the Republic of Singapore.

During the 2006 General Elections, Major General Konrote was elected into *Parliament as the Member for Rotuma* and appointed as the *Minister of State for Ex-Servicemen & Immigration*.

He returned to his home island of Rotuma in 2007 and was a *community* worker until the 2014 General Elections when he was again re-elected into Parliament and appointed Minister for Employment, Productivity and Industrial Relations in the present FIJIFIRST Bainimarama led Government.

Major General Konrote has had a very long, dedicated and distinguished career in serving Fiji as a Military Commander, an International Peacekeeper, a United Nations Assistant Secretary General and Force Commander UNIFIL, as a Senior Civil Servant, Permanent Secretary for Home Affairs & Immigration, as a Diplomat Head of Mission, Fiji's High Commissioner to the Commonwealth of Australia and Ambassador Plenipotentiary to the Republic of Singapore; and as a Parliamentarian, Minister of State for Ex-Servicemen & Immigration and presently, Minister for Employment, Productivity and Industrial Relations.

Major General Konrote's 5x decades of service for his country and the people of our beloved Fiji is a paragon of Loyalty, Courage and Devotion to Duty in his performance as a Military Commander, Honesty and Dedication as a Senior Civil Servant, Tact and Perseverance as a Diplomat and Care and Compassion as a Parliamentarian.
